

Crochet Water Bottle Holder



Sizes:one size

Finished measurements:bottle diameter: 3 in (8 cm),bottle height: 9 in (23 cm), handle drop: 23 in (58.5 cm)

Skills required:chain st, single crochet (sc)

Gauge:9sc = 2 in (5 cm)

Materials:

- **Yarn:**worsted weight, holding 2 strands together throughout
- **Hook:**US I
- **Notions:**yarn needle

Abbreviations:

sc = single crochet

ch = chain stitch

Instructions:

Chain 3, connect into a ring.

base:

Round 1: 5 sc around

Round 2: 2 sc in each sc around (10 sts)

Round 3: 2 sc in each sc around (20 sts)

Round 4: *(1 sc in 1st sc, 2 sc in next sc) repeat from * 10 times (30 sts)

Round 5: *(1 sc in 1st sc, 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in third sc) repeat from * 10 times (40 sts)

At this point you should have a flat circle that is 3 inches in diameter.

Rounds 6-13: 1 sc in each sc around

You'll see your flat circle becomes the bottom of your holder and the rounds 6-13 will naturally form the sides of the cup/bowl shape that holds the bottom of your bottle.

body:

Round 14: *(chain 3, 1 sc in 4th sc) repeat from * 8 times, ch 5, 1 sc around -not in- center stitch in first chain of this round

Rounds 15-29: *(ch 3, 1 sc around second stitch of chain below) repeat from * in a continuous spiral

Round 30: 1 sc around 3rd st of chain, 1 sc in sc *(1 sc around each of the 3 ch sts, 1 sc in sc) repeat from * to end of round

Rounds 31-38: 1 sc in each sc around

Do not break yarn.

strap:

Row 1: turn work, 1 sc in each of the next 9 sts

Row 2: turn work, 1 sc in each of the 9 sts

Repeat Row 2 until strap measures 47 in. (120 cm).

Cut yarn leaving a 8 in (20 cm) tail. Use yarn tail to attach loose end of strap to top edge of holder directly across from the starting end of the strap. Weave ends in.
