

# Sunflower Coaster Pot crochet pattern





Before diving into your crochet project, be sure to gather the necessary tools and familiarize yourself with the crochet symbols.



MR	Magic ring
ST(s)	Stitch(es)
SL	Slip stich
CH	Chain
SC	Single crochet
DC	Double crochet
INC	Increase
BLO	Back loop only
FLO	Front loop only
FPDC	Front post double crochet
BPDC	Back post double crochet
DC2TOG	Double crochet 2 together
DC3TOG	Double crochet 3 together

# Different types of foundations




Magic ring



Slst every round



Crochet on chain foundation



Crochet around chain foundation

## Note :

- You'll need one 50g ball of yarn per color.
- The pattern utilizes crochet terminology that is standard in the US.
- It is advisable to use a stitch marker to indicate the first stitch of each round to help keep track.
- The final size of the piece may differ depending on the yarn chosen and your stitch tension, measuring approximately 15 cm (about 5.9 inches).

This pattern is meant for personal use only; sharing or distributing it on social media or other platforms is not allowed.

# Pot

Use beige yarn

R1: 8SC in a MR (8)

R2: 8INC (16)

R3: (SC, INC) 8 times (24)

R4: (SC, INC, SC) 8 times (32) — LAST

R5: (3SC, INC) 8 times (40)

R6: (2SC, INC, 2SC) 8 times (48)

R7: BLO in all stitches, 2CH, 48DC (48)

R8-11: 2CH, (FPDC, BPDC) 24 times (48) 4 rounds total

R12: 48SC (48). Weave in the end and cut.



# Coaster

Begin with yellow yarn

R1: [3CH, (CH, DC) 9 times, CH] in a MR


Change to light yellow yarn

R2: Crochet into the spaces created by the CH stitches:

[CH, (DC, CH, DC, CH, DC) into the chain space, CH, slst into the next chain space] 5 times

# Coaster (cont.)



R3: Do not CH, [(SC, HDC) in one st, CH, (DC, 3CH, slst, 3CH, DC) in one st, CH, (HDC, SC) in one st, slst] 5 times



R4: Change to green yarn

- (3CH, DC2TOG) in one st, 3CH, skip 2 sts, SC into the previous DC/the point of the petal, 3CH, SC into the next previous DC/the point of the petal, 3CH, skip 2 sts
- [(DC3TOG, 3CH, skip 2 sts, SC into the previous DC/the point of the petal, 3CH, SC into the next previous DC/the point of the petal, 3CH, skip 2 sts] 4 times



# Coaster (cont.)

Change to white yarn

R5: Crochet into the spaces created by the CH stitches:

- 3CH, 2DC in the first chain space, CH,
- (3DC in the next chain space, CH) 14 times

R6:

- 3CH, 2DC, 2DC in the first chain space,
- (3DC, 2DC in the next chain space) 14 times



Change to green yarn

R7: (SC, 4CH, skip 2 sts) 25 times

R8: Crochet into the spaces created by the CH stitches:

{[SC, (4CH, slst in the second chain from the hook), 3CH, SC] in one chain space} 25 times

Weave in the end and cut.



# Sunflowers x 10

Begin with brown yarn

R1: 5SC in a MR (5)

R2: 5INC (10)

Change to yellow yarn

R3: [(2CH, 2DC, 2CH) in one st, slst in next st] 10 times

Weave in the end and cut.



## Assembly

- Sew the flowers around the edge of the coaster as shown.
- Fold the liner in half, then roll it into a small flower bouquet.
- You can use yarn to tie and secure the bouquet, making a bow.
- Place the bouquet into the pot and adjust the flowers to spread evenly inside the pot.
