



Pattern Abbreviations

English (US Terms)

ch - Chain:Yarn over, pull through loop on hook.

sc - Single Crochet:Insert hook into stitch, yarnover and pull through, yarn over and pull through last two loops on hook.

dc-Double Crochet:Yarn over, insert hook into stitch and pull through, yarn over and pull through first two loops on hook, yarnover and pull through last two loops on hook.

Materials:

- 4 balls of Lion Brand Coboo yarn in the color Beige or 928 yards of another light weight category 3 yarn.
- Size 4.0 mm crochet hook
- Darning Needle
- Scissors

Size:

Final size, after blocking: 31" x 31" inches.

Gauge:

10 rows x 8 stitches = 4 inches in single crochet

8 rows x 8 stitches = 4 inches in double crochet

Pattern Notes:

- Pattern written in U.S Terms.
- Tassels are optional for this pattern.

Crochet Baby Blanket Pattern

ch 125

R1: 4 dc in 5th ch from hook, *skip next 3 ch, 4 dc in next ch; rep from * across to within last 4 ch, skip next 3 ch, 3 dc in last ch, turn.

R2: ch 1, sc in each dc across, ending with last sc in top of turning ch, turn.

R3: ch 3 (counts as dc), skip first sc, 2 dc in next sc, *skip next 3 sc, 4 dc in next sc; rep from * across to within last 2 sc, skip next sc, dc in last sc, turn.

R4: Rep Row 2

R5: ch 3 (counts as dc), skip first 3 sc, *4 dc in next sc, skip next 3 sc; rep from * across to within last sc, 3 dc in last sc, turn.

R6-R78: Repeat rows 2-5.

Last row will be a repeat of row 2 (single crochet).

Cut yarn and weave in ends.

Tassel Tutorial

You will need a total of 4 tassels.

Supplies

-Lion Brand Coboo yarn in the color Beige(1 ball/leftover yarn from pattern)

- Small to medium size book

- Scissors

Step 1:

Wrap yarn around the book for a total of 50 times.

Step 2:

Gently remove the wrapped yarn of the book.

Step 3:

Cut an additional piece of yarn and put it under the yarn that you just removed from the book (approx. 1/2" from the top).

Once you have the yarn underneath the bunched up yarn, you want to tie a knot to secure it. This will create a loop on top (hole).

Step 4:

Cut all the bottom loops and trim the yarn so it's perfectly even.

Finally, cut an additional piece of string and loop it through the top of the tassel. This string is used to attach the tassel to the corners of the baby blanket.

Create a total of 4 tassels. 1 for each corner of the blanket.
